Hello Sunday! Setting the stage

With athletes from Canada arriving, the stage will soon be set for the third edition of the Arctic Winter Games as nearly 1,000 competitors make their bid for the gold, silver and bronze ulus during the next six days.

By late this evening all 930 athletes competing in the Games should be bedded down at Camp Carroll, their home for the next week, resting up for the official opening ceremony Monday and the beginning of more than 800 separate sporting events.

Sixteen sports are on the agenda this year, four more than the 1972 Games in Whitehorse, Yukon Territory and six more than the initial contests held in Yellowknife, The Northwest Territories, in 1970.

Athletes will be competing in modified biathlon, cross-country skiing, curling, figure skating, hockey, snowshoeing, badminton, basketball, volleyball, Arctic sports, archery, boxing, judo, shooting, table tennis and wrestling.

In addition, there are exhibitions planned in gymnastics, police pistol shooting and swimming, with several cultural activities scheduled throughout the city in association with the Games.

In the kick-off series at Yellowknife, the NWT squad easily out-distanced the other teams to capture the title. But, in Whitehorse, two years ago, the host Yukon squad barely squeezed out a narrow half-point victory. It shows the progress of the teams during only the two years between matches. Alaska finished in the runner-up slot both times.

If that is any indication, this year's activities should be equally as competitive, since all the countries have had two more years to groom the squad they feel best represents their particular area.

Although there are no new additions to this year's field (Arctic Quebec joined the 1972 competition), observers from Labrador will be in attendance with the intention of joining the Games in 1976 at a site which will be named at the conclusion of this year's Games. Greenland is also expected to have observers here as they did at Whitehorse last time.

While the late arrivals are trickling in this evening, the banquet, hosted by Anchorage Mayor George Sullivan and the Arctic Winter Games Commission will be held at the Anchorage Westward Hotel, official headquarters of the AWG. The banquet starts at 8:30 p.m. with Gov. William Egan welcoming the teams to Alaska for the first AWG in the state.

Most sporis will start their activities early Monday morning, with the official opening ceremonies planned at noon in the downtown area near the railroad depot.

The athletes will meet near mid-morning and start the parade from the Park Strip, leading to the ceremony site, about 10 blocks away, at 10:30 a.m.

In addition to a welcoming program, the official torch on the City Hall grounds will be lighted by a runner, carrying the flame from the ceremony site. It will remain burning throughout the Games.

Canadians arriving here today

Eight special charter flights descend on Anchorage International Airport through the day carrying the Canadian delegations for the Third Arctic Winter Games.

The Northwest Territories, which has half the charters, is the first and last to arrive. The initial NWT group landed early this morning. The three remaining jets will continue transporting the athletes, officials, coaches and spectators, with the last group set to land at 12:20 a.m. Monday. Each plane will have nearly 120 passengers.

The defending champion Yukon Territory squad has three flights planned, while the Arctic Quebec team will arrive in one group at 8:45 this evening.

Yukon flights are scheduled at 11:20 a.m., 2:55 p.m. and 4:05 p.m.

Shortly after arrival, the athletes will be taken to Camp Carroll, their home during the week-long activities, to settle into the surroundings and prepare for the six days of competition.

ern athletes for national and international competition, the Arctic Winter Games have become an "end in themselves."

As in the first two meetings, the Games continue to furnish an opportunity for cultural meeting of northern peoples through competition. With representatives from Arctic Quebec, The Northwest Territories, the Yukon Territory and Alaska, the Games are an accomplishment of logistics just to bring everyone together.

Canadians traveling up to 4,500 miles will be participating, some of whom have never seen a city as large as Anchorage before. The total population of all the participating areas would only make one medium-sized city if combined in one place. The largest city in all of the three Canadian units is Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, with approximately 11,000 people.

"There were wide discrepancies between athletes in the first Games, with some teams wiping everyone else out in certain sports," explained Brian Purdy, president of the AWG Corporation. "But the discrepancies weren't as apparent in the second Games, and I expect that those teams which lest him in earlier Games will that those teams which lost big in earlier Games will be tougher now."

Purdy, a bush lawyer from The Northwest Territories, serves as the legal director for the corporation. He says that since the Games were organized, recreation organizations have sprung up all over the areas involved.

"And sometimes my job comes down to nourishing seven other infants through their temper-tantrums," adds Purdy.

I guess I got involved in this because I like to do the nitty-gritty of sports," said Claude LaCasse, in a French Arctic Quebec accent. "We need to make the governments realize the importance of healthy competition among northern peoples."

One of the two board members representing Arctic Quebec, LaCasse says he's particularly concerned that the Arctic Winter Games don't become "just another competition."

"This is not elite competition," says LaCasse. "This is for anyone who likes to compete.

LaCasse works for Sport Canada, the government organization which sponsored the first two Arctic Winter Games and has helped pay for transporting Canadian teams to Alaska for this year's events. Athletes from Quebec will fly to Montreal where a DC-8 will take over for the rest of the trip. The cost of the flight to Anchorage: \$53,000.

"But that Canadian price won't necessarily apply to flying if the 1976 Games should be held in Quebec," added Bill Barrett, one of the Alaska representatives for the corporation.

Regional Quebec Games are held twice every year in an effort to develop athletes in that area. LaCasse says Quebec may not be ready to host the Games yet, but possibly in the near future.

"In 1972, we came to the games with 85 play-said LaCasse. "Now we're going to have 152 ers," said LaCasse. it's becoming something for everyone to shoot for."

Sixteen compulsory sports will be represented at the Games with three exhibition sports of police pistol shooting, gymnastics and synchronized swimming. The optional events are decided upon by the Anchorage AWG commission which is actually responsible for success of the biennial event.

"The people of Yukon Territories look forward

to these Games," said Roy Reber, who coached the 1967 Canadian hockey team at the Canada Games, Last time, Reber was responsible for coordinating his area's team.

"When they held the trials for these Games, pedple from all over the 476,000 square miles of the Yukon Territory came together," continued Reber. "The trials are a big part of the fun."

Two Wien 737 aircraft will be bringing the total of 300 people involved with the Games here from Yukon Territory. Most will be athletes (230 in all) and the rest will be VIPs, referees, officials and

The Arctic Winter Games Corporation awarded the contract for the 1974 Games in June of 1972 following announcement that Anchorage had been decided upon at the conclusion of the 1972 Games.

The ulu-award for excellence

The ulu, a utility knife developed and used by the Arctic people, is the form used for the Arctic Winter Games medals. During the third competition in Anchorage, 816 of these medals will be presented.

The winner in each category will receive the gold replica, while the silver and bronze will be awarded to the second and third place finishers.


The medals are engraved with the Games symbol, three interlocking circles on a blue background, which represents the union of the people of the North participating together in sporting and cultural activities.


