# LTURAL

Here's an outline of the exciting performing and visual art programs that make up the Arctic Winter Games Cultural Festival:

### PERFORMING ARTS

The Gala:

Presented by the N.W.T. Arts Council, the Cultural Festival features an evening of performers from all regions represented in the Arctic Winter Games including Greenland and the Soviet Union with a special em-phasis on talent from the Northwest Territories. Tickets are available at the NACC ticket booth at Panda II Mall. (Evening Performances: General Admission: \$15.00 Seniors/Students: \$10.00 NACC Public Preview on March 14: Seniors: Free; Students: \$5.00).

Storytelling at the Mess:

The Cultural Festival, with the assistance of the Department of Culture and Communications, presents two evenings of storytelling by storytellers representing a variety of northern cultures. Oldtime musicians provide entertainment to accompany tales from all across the north. Doors open at 7:30 pm. (Miner's Mess)

Northern Exposures: A Film Festival: The Yellowknife Film Society, in cooperation with the Cultural Festival, presents a festival of films by and about northerners. The matinee presentation features films for the whole family while the evening show offers a cross section of excellent northern films. (NACC)

Caribou Stew:

An Evening of New Northern Theatre: Drama R'us and the Cultural Festival pre-sent an evening of dramatic works by northern playrights and performers. A showcase of readings and selected scenes, this presentation highlights new directions for northern theatre in an informal setting. (Heritage Centre)

#### The Kids' Gala:

Kids' Unlimited and the Cultural Festival present an afternoon of activities and entertainment for children. Cultural performers of special interest to young people will share their talent and a variety of creative activities will be made available. (Heritage Centre)

The CBC Noonshow at Panda II Mall: CBC Radio broadcasts live from Panda II Mall every day of the Cultural Festival. Listen for entertainment by and interviews with performers and up to date information about the Cultural Festival. (Panda II)

VISUAL ARTS

The NWT Arts Council Exhibition: Some of the finest artists in the Territories are represented at this exhibition of artists supported by the NWT Arts Council. A diversity of styles and techniques are displayed in this spectacular showcase of northern visual arts. (10:00 am to 5:00 pm Tuesday to Saturday - Leg. Assembly)

Historical Selections from the Esso Resources Canadian Art Collection: This exhibit is presented by the Prince of Wales Heritage Centre in co-operation with Esso Resources. A grand history of Canadian art is portrayed in a series of paintings by classic Canadian artists. (Heritage Centre hours - Sunday to Saturday - Heritage Centre)

Artists Respond: A People in Peril: The Visual Arts Centre of Anchorage has provided to the Cultural Festival a chilling exhibit focusing on modern threats to native culture in Alaska as seen by native Alaskan artists. (1 pm to 7 pm Monday to Friday — Council Chambers)

There's a Hole in My Roof: Environmental concern and the disappearing ozone layer are the topics of this thought provoking exhibit of Yukon artists assembled by the Territorial Art Gallery in Whitehorse. (1 pm to 6 pm Monday to Friday — Northern United Place)

Yellowknife Photo Club Display: The Yellowknife Photo Club, in co-operation with Cultural Festival, presents a group exhibit of photos both northern and nonnorthern in theme. (Opens in conjunction with events at NACC)

Yellowknife Guild of Crafts Handicrafts

The Guild of Crafts presents a display of both traditional and contemporary crafts by Territorial crafters. Demonstrations and a sale will be featured in this two day exhibit. (Friday 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm and Saturday 10:00 am to 3:00 pm - Northern United

Yellowknife Correctional Centre Carving

Display: YCC, in co-operation with the Cultural Festival, presents a two day exhibit of carvings by carvers at the Correctional Centre. Demonstrations of traditional carving will be held weather permitting. (1:00 pm to 7:00 pm Thursday and Friday — Wildcat)


